

Course Description

WorkSafeBC has specified training for Joint Committee members as follows; “All joint committee members selected on or after April 3, 2017 must receive eight hours of training and instruction on the following topics.” (see table below).

Our training meets the content requirements from WorkSafeBC, yet does NOT meet the 8-hour requirement. We’ve found through experience that these topics can be diligently covered in 6 hours. If your organizations wants to ensure a full 8 hours of training is provided, then WorkSafeBC has designed a [2-hour online course](#) (free) that can be used to supplement our training.
